- ◆ Evening dinner & closing conference program with host families

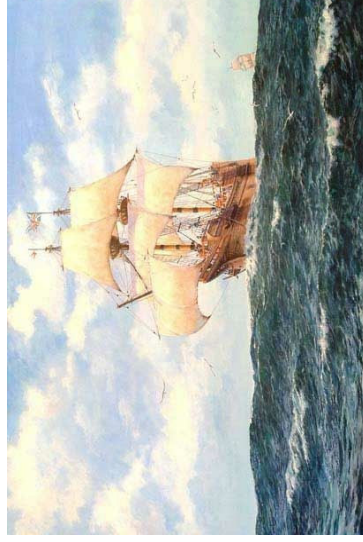
### Sunday:
