

Jubilee Conference 2012
(information for PSU international students)
February 17- 19, 2012
(Or just come for the day on Saturday, Feb. 18)

God cares about every person and every part of His creation. That includes colleges and universities, academic majors and future occupations. What does it look like to be faithful to following Jesus in these settings? How do you integrate your faith and your learning? Is there hope for our broken world? We don't want to settle for easy answers to tough questions. The annual JUBILEE Conference in Pittsburgh is designed to help you wrestle deeply with the challenges of being a follower of Jesus, and a citizen of His Kingdom in this world. It's a great opportunity to spend some time thinking about life and where and how we fit into the world. It's also a good time of fellowship, and a special experience to be there with 1500+ other college students in the Pittsburgh Convention Center. Please plan your schedule so you can attend! ICF can provide a scholarship to pay much of the costs!

The JUBILEE Conference will be held at the Westin Convention Center in Pittsburgh on Feb. 17-19. **As part of our PSU international group you have two options:** 1.) You can attend the entire weekend of the Conference, with Walt and Sue Johnston, my fellow IMPS/CCO staff members coordinating that group; or 2.) You can attend the conference just for the day on Saturday with me. (We will leave State College at 7 AM- I will pick you up wherever you live in State College- and return by midnight.)

The 2 parts of our PSU international student group will hang out together on Saturday. During the Saturday afternoon "Breakout Sessions" you can choose between a variety of speakers and topics. Over the lunch break we will explore some of downtown Pittsburgh together. In the evening there will be some great singing and a featured speaker. (Also, there are special Jubilee "Cross-Cultural" programs available for Asian, African and African-American students, and Latino students.)

Costs: If you plan to attend the full weekend and you register on-line before Jan. 27, the Conference Fee is \$169, with an additional cost of \$90 for staying at the hotel, for a total of \$259. We are able to provide scholarship funds to pay \$160 of these costs, so you pay only \$99 (\$119 after Jan. 27). If you attend just for the day on Saturday, we will provide scholarship funds so you pay only \$25.

Registration: To register for the full weekend of Jubilee Conference you need to first register at the Jubilee website (www.jubileeconference.com) website (say "yes" to the prompt about being in a CCO Ministry) and then pay only the \$50 deposit. Then complete the extra registration form below and return it to me no later than Jan. 27 with the additional \$49 (cash or check payable to "CCO"). To be part of our Saturday-only group, just complete and return the form below with \$25 to be registered. We will then formally register on Saturday morning when we arrive at Jubilee.
